- 1. Applicant must be a member in good standing at R-S Bellco.

- 6. Applicants that have not been awarded a scholarship previously may receive preference over previous winners. However, previous winners are eligible to be awarded a scholarship in multiple years. (Maximum of 2 scholarship per student)
- 7. Five \$1000 scholarships will be awarded this year, and a panel of judges from outside the Credit Union will select recipients.
- 8. All applications and required information must be received by May 1, 2023 and sent to the following address only:
